




CURRICULUM & DISCIPLINES



International students, as free movers, can apply at 4 different stages of their curriculum:

- In the **last year of their Bachelor's degree**: international students can either be admitted through the competitive entrance examination or based on their academic file;
- In the first and/or the second year of their Master's degree: international students can apply directly via the Université Paris-Saclay portal: <u>https://www.universite-paris-</u> saclay.fr/en/apply-to-master-programs);
- For admission in a PhD programme: applications can be directly discussed with ENS Paris-Saclay laboratories.
